<p>thisbornagain.sh script is used to quickly setup PYTHONPATH and LD_LIBRARY_PATH to point on BornAgain installation directory.</p> <p>Inside, it tries to remove previous installation, but does it wrongly, producing following paths</p> <pre>PYTHONPATH=/opt/BornAgain/lib/BornAgain-1.7:/BornAgain-1.6</pre> <p>i.e. first part '/opt/BornAgain/lib/BornAgain-1.7' is as it should be, second part '/BornAgain-1.6' shouldn't be there.</p> <p>This item is closely related to the installation directory structure.
