Dear Rainer,

this was a bug in our code and it was already fixed in our development branch couple of weeks ago.

For the moment you can try our development builds from <http://apps.jcns.fz-juelich.de/src/BornAgain/experimental/>

Alternatively, you can keep using 1.9.0, just replace the line
`ba.plot_intensity_data(result)`

with
`from matplotlib import pyplot as plt`
`ba.plot_colormap(result)`
`plt.show()`

The release 1.10.0 is scheduled for the end of September. If we discover more bugs, then bugfix release might come sooner.
