Description

It must be possible at any moment to mark an issue as rejected or resolved or "in progress".

The workflow described by Walter (now at <http://apps.jcns.fz-juelich.de/doku/sc/intern:redmine>) is convincing as a default and as a convention, but it must not be so hard wired that non-standard actions require ugly workarounds (like setting an issue to backlog then sprint only to close it).

I also think that sprint items should never be directly put to "close", but that we do this in one shot at the end of the sprint, so that everyone has at least an opportunity to comment/review/...
